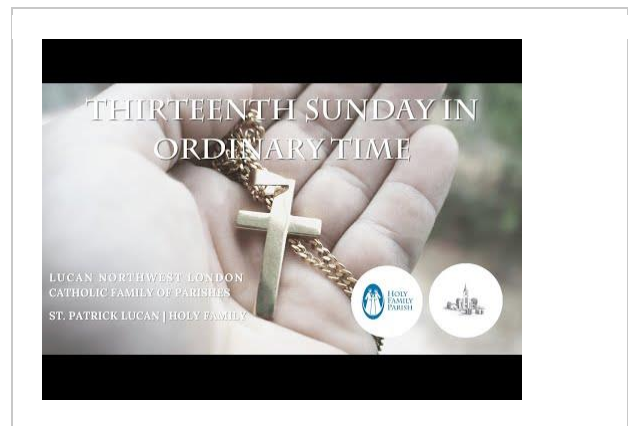

KING'S UNIVERSITY COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES FOR CATHOLIC STUDENTS THIS YEAR

Scholarships are available to Catholic students who are beginning full-time studies at King's. These are meant to help those "whose financial situation makes the pursuit of a university education unusually difficult", and who, it is hoped, will make a contribution to the Catholic community and society in the future.

One scholarship is given in honour of Bishop John Sherlock, ninth Bishop of London (1978-2002), and one in honour of Thomas Cardinal Collins, the current Archbishop of Toronto. Full details and the application information are available on King's website, at this [link](#).

The following is a brief description of the Bishop Sherlock Award "This scholarship of \$4,000.00 is granted to a full-time first year student (whether a high school, mature and transfer student) who is a member of a parish within the Diocese of London and whose financial situation makes the pursuit of a university education unusually difficult.

This award is intended to encourage the education of those with the potential to make a positive contribution to the Catholic community and to the common good of society. Candidates must demonstrate large financial need, meet the minimum academic entrance requirements and provide a pastor letter of reference.

If the student remains registered full-time, maintains a minimum average of 70%, demonstrates continued involvement in a parish and includes one credit in Catholic Studies, or Religious Studies with a Catholic theme, within his or her degree credits, a scholarship of \$3000.00 is renewable for Year 2, 3 and 4.

The application deadline has been extended.

SUPPORTING THE PEOPLE OF UKRAINE

For those who want to donate to support the people of Ukraine and the agencies working on the ground to aid them, two options are recommended.

The papal agency the Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA) was founded in 1926 and for over 90 years has been helping the poor in the middle east and other trouble spots around the world. They are accepting donations in Canada for their people on the ground providing assistance. Canadians can donate to them at this [cnewa.org/ca/donate/]link and remember to select "Ukraine" from the "Donate To" drop down menu.

Development and Peace - Caritas Ukraine and Caritas SPES are also on the ground aiding those in need.
